# Make a Difference, Even If You're Little!

Do your kids want to help shelter animals? Paw Pals Jr. is a special volunteer program just for kids ages 5–11, where they can make a BIG impact on the lives of shelter pets—alongside their parent or guardian. Our junior volunteers help with important behind-thescenes tasks that keep our animals healthy, happy, and ready to be adopted. While these young volunteers won't work hands-on with large dogs (for safety reasons), they'll still be part of the team that helps care for them!

When a child turns 12, they can graduate to our full volunteer program, where they'll receive additional training and can start helping more directly with the animals.

## Who Can Join? Kids ages 5 to 11

Must be accompanied by a parent or guardian the entire time

No more than 2 children per adult is allowed for safety reasons





# What Can Junior Volunteers Do?

- Help with laundry (cleaning blankets, beds, and towels)
- 🔽 Wash food and water bowls
- Make enrichment treats and toys for the animals
- Hand out treats (with staff guidance)
- Reading to the animals
- Sweep and tidy walkways and common areas
- Safety Note: Junior Volunteers will be allowed in animal areas, but they will not have hands-on interaction with large dogs or animals under behavior review.







# 👕 What Should You Wear?

- Closed-toe shoes are a must think sneakers, not sandals
- Clothes should be comfortable and easy to wash (you may get messy!)
- No spaghetti straps, crop tops, or offensive graphics
- Long pants are recommended to protect legs
- Long hair should be tied back
- Lanyards will be provided for identification while on site.

## Volunteer Conduct & Expectations

As a shelter open to the public, we want every customer — and every animal — to feel welcome, safe, and cared for. We ask that Paw Pals Jr. volunteers and their adults: Use kind voices and calm behavior inside the shelter Follow all staff instructions carefully Be respectful to staff, animals, other volunteers, and visitors Stay positive — your attitude helps animals find homes! Treat this like a job: be dependable, show up on time, and be ready to help

Volunteers are ambassadors for CCAS — your teamwork and attitude help create a great experience for everyone!
