What is CERT?

CERT is a training program that prepares you to help yourself, your family, and your neighbors in the event of a disaster.

A community emergency response team is a team of individuals who receive specialized training that enhances their ability to recognize, prepare for, respond to, and recover from a major emergency or disaster.

During a disaster, emergency personnel might not be able to reach everyone right away. By getting trained in CERT, you will have the skills to help emergency responders save lives and protect property.
