**1. Introductions**

**2. C-FORT Updates**

- Review of Overdose Data, ED Visits Data, Louis Leake- *Mr. Leake provided data on emergency room visits and overdose data in NC and Cumberland County.*
- Agency Updates – *CFORT members provided updates regarding their agencies to include community events, conferences and upcoming meetings.*

**3. Provide Overview of the Settlement funds**

- *Cumberland County is estimated to receive \$16,984,644 over an 18-year period (2022-2038). The City of Fayetteville is estimated to receive \$1,994,964 during the same 18-year period.*
- Receive general feedback on available strategies that can be funded
  - *Under **Option A**, a local government may fund one or more strategies from a shorter list (Exhibit A) of evidence-based, high-impact strategies to address the epidemic.*
  - *Under **Option B**, a local government engages in a collaborative strategic planning process (Exhibit C) involving a diverse array of stakeholders and may then fund a strategy from the Exhibit A list or a longer list of strategies (Exhibit B) included in the national settlements.*
- Input on prioritization of specific strategies
  - *Early intervention*
  - *Evidence-based addiction treatment for the uninsured and underinsured*
  - *Programs to support people in treatment and recovery*
  - *Recovery support services*
    - *Recovery housing*
    - *Employment related services*
    - *Re-entry services*
    - *Criminal justice diversion programs*
