Agenda Item 2. Data Updates

Louis Leake, Carolina Treatment Center

-This data is for the month of September

-CC 2023 YTD: 192 Opioid overdose emergency Department visits. Compared to 193 on January-September 2022 (there is normally a spike during the holidays).

-Ages 24-25 are affected the most.

-CC 2023 YTD: 504 ED visits for overdose involving medications/drugs.

-CC 6/2023: 285 emergency medical services (EMS) encounter for suspected opioid overdose encounters.

Charlton Roberson, NCHRC

-The number of syringes that NCHRC has distributed as of September were three hundred fiftytwo thousand nine hundred and ten syringes.

-4,822 doses of Narcan

-425 doses of Narcan (over the last 2 months)

-1,569 peer-to-peer reversals (as of September)

-1,377 biohazard kits distributed.

-We are also involved in LEAD; and was able to get 2 homeless individuals from our community into stable recovery environments.

-Post overdose response: we will become more active in these efforts.
