Home Births

Home births must be registered at the Department of Health. If a NC Certified Nurse Midwife attended your delivery, the midwife will assist you with this process.

For any unattended home birth, the mother is responsible for registering the birth with the department of health in the county where the birth occurred.

The following are required for registering the birth:

- Proof of delivery or pregnancy (records of prenatal care, ultrasound, etc.)
- Proof of address where birth occurred (i.e., a utility bill delivered by USPS)
- Valid Government issued ID Acceptable forms of ID:
 - State-issued driver's license
 - State-issued non-driver photo ID
 - US Passport
 - US military ID (with signature)
 - Veteran's ID card
 - Tribal enrollment card
 - Work authorization card
 - Permanent resident card

Affidavit of Parentage

If the parents of a child are not legally married, but wish to have the biological father's name added to the birth certificate an Affidavit of Parentage (AOP) must be completed.

If this was not completed at the hospital where the child was born, you can make an appointment with the Deputy Registrar at the Cumberland County Department of Public Health for assistance.

Please note, upon completion of the AOP, it can take up to 6 weeks for your child's birth record to be updated at the Register of Deeds office.

The following are required to complete an Affidavit of Parentage:

- A certified copy of child's NC birth certificate
- Both parents must be present
- Both parents must present valid ID (see list of acceptable forms of ID)
- Social Security numbers for both parents
