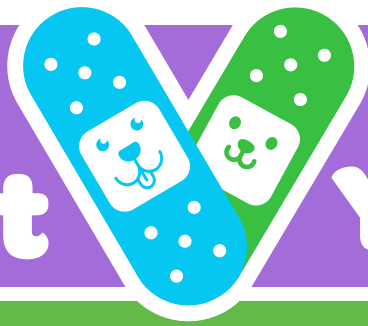

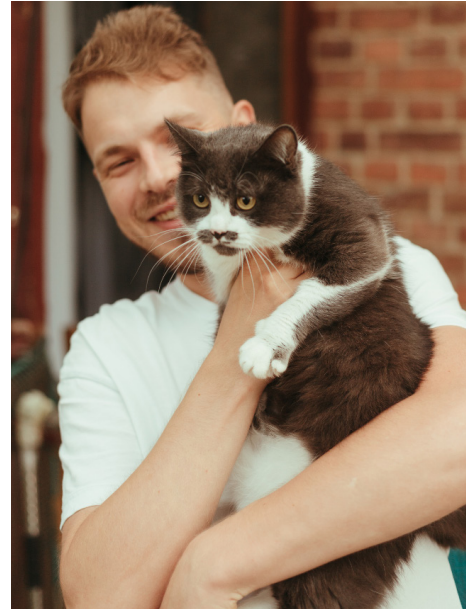

Vax Your Pet

Rabies Vaccinations

\$5 per dog or cat

Cash only. Please bring exact change.

No checks or credit cards accepted. No rolled coins.

- Keep your dog on a leash.
- Keep your cats in separate carriers or boxes or leave them in your car with the windows down or the air conditioner switched on.
- Owners may be held responsible for their pets and for any damage they cause.

To **remain properly immunized**, a dog or cat must receive **two** rabies vaccinations one year apart, then **one** vaccination every three years thereafter. **NORTH CAROLINA LAW: The owner of every dog and cat over four months of age shall have the animal vaccinated against rabies.** In Cumberland County, the owners of dogs and cats that have not been vaccinated in accordance with this law are subject to a civil penalty in the amount of \$100.

COVID-19 & Flu

COVID-19 and flu vaccines are **FREE** to all regardless of insurance status. Ages 6 months and up are eligible to take the COVID-19 vaccine. Eligibility criteria for individuals seeking booster shots can be found on our website at www.cumberlandcountync.gov/publichealth.

Clinics The **STD Express Clinic** and **Immunizations Clinic** will be open during event. Immunizations will not be doing PPD reads or placements. No appointments required for COVID and flu vaccines. Call 910-433-3600 for an appointment with the STD Express Clinic.
