

Vax Your Pet

Rabies Vaccinations 5 per dog or cat

Cash only. Please bring exact change.

No checks or credit cards accepted. No rolled coins.

- Keep your dog on a leash.
- Keep your cats in separate carriers or boxes or leave them in your car with the windows down or the air conditioner switched on.
- Owners may be held responsible for their pets and for any damage they cause.

To remain properly immunized, a dog or cat must receive two rabies vaccinations one year apart, then one vaccination every three years thereafter. NORTH CAROLINA LAW: The owner of every dog and cat over four months of age shall have the animal vaccinated against rabies. In Cumberland County, the owners of dogs and cats that have not been vaccinated in accordance with this law are subject to a civil penalty in the amount of \$100.
