Keep your ebtEDGE account private and secure. For security purposes, never share your password or eWIC card number with anyone outside of WIC and ebtEDGE.

Change your PIN.

Enter the requested information to verify your identity, then enter and confirm your new PIN and click Save.

Register to receive and send text messages.

Send or receive emails or text messages about your account from FIS.

Order a replacement card by mail.

If it's lost, stolen or damaged.

Scan a product on the shelf.

Find out if a product is a part of your WIC benefits before getting to the checkout. From the Account Summary screen, tap See More to access the barcode scanner. Simply scan the barcode of a product with your smartphone or enter in the product code using the keypad to check whether the product is WIC-approved.
