

Annual Application for Reduced Ad Valorem Tax Valuation of Antique Airplanes

Pursuant to N.C.G.S. §105-277.12, antique airplanes are designated a special class of property under Article V, Sec. 2(2) of the North Carolina Constitution and are eligible for assessment at a reduced tax valuation. If qualified, they shall be assessed at the lower of their true value or five thousand dollars (\$5,000).

To apply for antique valuation, please complete the below application in its entirety. **Applications are due annually by January 31**st. You may submit your application in person at our office located in the Cumberland County Courthouse, 117 Dick Street, Suite 530, Fayetteville.
