OF RESOLUTION OF INTENT TO CLOSE A PORTION OF SPRUCE STREET LOCATED BETWEEN WALNUT STREET (NOW KNOWN AS STONECASTLE STREET) AND MAPLE STREET AS RECORDED IN PLAT BOOK 10, PAGE 01

IN THE CUMBERLAND COUNTY REGISTRY.

BACKGROUND: Property owner Mr. George Jefferson Kelly petitioned that a portion of Spruce Street located in Pearce's Mill Township be closed. His petition is attached as Exhibit A. A map of the area is attached as Exhibit B and C.


The Department of Transportation confirms that this portion of Spruce Street between Walnut Street (now known as Stonecastle Street) and Maple Street is not a State maintained road and has no objection to the abandonment. The Fire Marshall also does not object. The Planning Department recommends approval of the closing provided the following conditions are complied with:

- 1. The parcels indentified by PIN: 0425-97-3198-; 0425-97-4158- & 0425-97-5137- are recombined together into one lot with a minimum of 20 feet of road frontage;
- 2. If only half of Spruce Street it to be combined with the three lots, then the remaining half of Spruce Street must be combined with the property to the east PIN: 0425-97-8056-;
- 3. The recombination plat must be submitted to the Planning & Inspections Department Meeting the platting requirements prior to being recorded at the Register of Deeds office.

Mr. Kelly has provided the County with an executed deed which meets the Planning Departments requirements and has submitted a plat which meets the plotting requirements.

Pursuant to G. S. 153A-241, if the Board desires to honor the request, the Board must declare its intent to close a portion Spruce Street between Walnut Street (now known as Stonecastle Street) and Maple Street and call for a public hearing on the matter. I have attached a resolution for your consideration. The resolution will (1) authorize the Board to set a public hearing to consider whether to close a portion of Spruce Street, (2) direct that notice be published once a week for four successive weeks before the hearing, and (3) direct that a notice of the closing and public hearing be prominently posted in at least two places along the street during that time. Staff will also mail a copy of the notice to the other property owners adjoining the Spruce Street.

**RECOMMENDATION AND PROPOSED ACTION:** That the Board of Commissioners consider adoption of the attached resolution calling for a public hearing and declaring the Board's intent to consider the petition to close a portion of Spruce Street.



**SUBJECT:** Approval To Purchase Used CAT 320 CL

Request permission to purchase used CAT 320 CL serial number PAB06597 with approximately 2,555.8 hours on it for use at the landfill. This machine will come with a 500-hour Powertrain Warranty. See attached quote. Gregory Poole has a used machine for \$130,000.00 which they will sell to us for \$111,280.00. Solid Waste Management has been renting a machine like this for \$5,203 per month.

Monies were budgeted under capital outlay for this equipment.

The reason why we would like to purchase this machine now is because it has been on rental fleet, is in like very good to new condition, and with the economy the way it is now we believe that Cumberland County will be saving a lot of money in the purchase of this machine as we will have to buy a machine like this within the near future.

The County has paid \$26,000.00 in rent on this machine and we owe \$10,406.00 in rent on this machine (if we do not purchase it). Gregory Poole offered to sell us the machine using 70% of the \$26,000.00 paid in rent, which would be \$18,200.00. This amount would be subtracted from the \$130,000.00 asking price and they would add back \$817.00 that they have spent in servicing this equipment.

I told the CAT salesman that I would ask permission to purchase this machine if he would sell it to us for \$104,000.00 (the original asking price minus the total monies paid in rent) plus \$4,680.00 state sales tax, \$2,600.00 county sales tax for a total of \$111,280.00 and we would not pay any rent we owe for.

It is my belief that this is a great deal for Solid Waste.


