



BACKGROUND: Property owner Charles A. Allen and Cindy M. Allen petitioned that a portion of a forty foot unnamed street located in Pearces Mill Township be closed. Their petition is attached as Exhibit A. A map of the area is attached as Exhibit B and C.

The Department of Transportation confirms that this portion of the unnamed street located on the northern side of Dedication Drive and the western side of Gillespie Street is not a State maintained road and has no objection to the abandonment. Neither the Fire Marshall nor the Planning Department objects to the closing of that portion of the forty foot unnamed street.

Pursuant to G. S. 153A-241, if the Board desires to honor the request, the Board must declare its intent to close a portion of the forty foot unnamed street located on the northern side of Dedication Drive and the western side of Gillespie Street and call for a public hearing on the matter. I have attached a resolution for your consideration. The resolution will (1) authorize the Board to set a public hearing to consider whether to close a portion of the forty foot unnamed street, (2) direct that notice be published once a week for three successive weeks before the hearing, and (3) direct that a notice of the closing and public hearing be prominently posted in at least two places along the street during that time. Staff will also send by certified mail a copy of the notice to the other property owners adjoining the forty foot unnamed street.





RESOLUTION OF INTENT TO CLOSE PUBLIC ROAD AND CALL FOR PUBLIC HEARING ON THE OUESTION

WHEREAS, Charles A. Allen and Cindy M. Allen submitted a petition to the Cumberland County Board of Commissioners (the "Board") to close a portion of a forty foot unnamed street located on the northern side of Dedication Drive and the western side of Gillespie Street in Pearces Mill Township, Cumberland County; and

WHEREAS, it appears that such public street is not under the control of the North Carolina Department of Transportation: that no person would be deprived of reasonable means of ingress and egress to his or her property by such closing; and that such closing would therefore not be contrary to the public interest;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board will consider the issue of whether to close the following public street in accordance with North Carolina General Statute, Section 153A-241:

Being that portion of the unnamed street 40 feet in width as shown on the plat filed in Book 9 at page 39 in the Cumberland County Registry from its southern-most terminus in the street identified as NC State Road No. 1344 on the plat filed in Book 34 at page 53 (now named Dedication Drive) to its intersection with the line running from the north-eastern corner of Lot 39 and the north-western corner of Lot 12 as shown on the plat filed in Book 9 at page 39.

AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Board calls for and shall hold a public hearing on the question of the closing of such street on the 15th day of March, 2010 at 6:45 p.m. in the Commissioners Meeting Room (Room 118), First Floor, New Courthouse, 117 Dick Street, Fayetteville, North Carolina. The Board shall hear all interested persons who appear with respect to whether the closing would be detrimental to the public interest or to any individual's property rights.

AND BE IT FURTHER DIRECTED, that notice of consideration of whether to close said street and of the public hearing on such matter shall be published once week for four successive weeks before the hearing in a newspaper of general circulation in Cumberland County and posted in at least two places along the street during the time; and that a copy of this resolution shall be sent by certified mail to each owner as shown on the county tax records of property adjoining the public road or easement who did not join in the request to have the road or easement closed.



The North Carolina Department of Transportation has received petitions requesting the following streets be placed on the State Secondary Road System for maintenance (see attached):





BACKGROUND:

We received bids for Alternate Daily Cover. The low bid company that met specifications was RUSMAR. They had two bids. The first bid was \$0.255 per square foot and that would be on a measured square foot invoiced and paid monthly. The second bid, and the one that Solid Waste recommends, is \$0.098 per square foot. We would pay for the Foam Concentrate at a cost: \$0.98(U.S.)/lb. The calculation would work out as illustrated below:

Concentrate is diluted 7.5:1 (6.5 parts water + 1 part concentrate)

One gallon of water weighs 8.34 lbs.

Each gallon of diluted chemical contains 1.11 lbs. of concentrate $([1 \div 7.5] \times 8.34 \text{ lbs.} = 1.11 \text{ lbs.})$

1.11 lbs/gallon x 0.98/lb. = 1.0878/gallon

Usage rate at a depth of 3 inches is 0.09 gallons/ft2

Cost per square foot = \$0.0979

We have been measuring the square footage of the waste that we would have to cover and based on an average of that it will cost us somewhere in the neighborhood of \$172,873 (using the Optional Pricing part of their bid). Also, we would only have to use one employee and RUSMAR's equipment. Wherein the past we had to use our dozer and two employees and it cost us \$196,680.90 last year to use the ADC provided by Posi-Shell. Now there could be a variance in the amount of space that we have to cover but it is believed that us not having to utilize our D7 Bulldozer to pull the applicator with the Posi-Shell concept and only having to use one employee and not be responsible for repairs of an applicator it is cheaper and safer to use the RUSMAR concept. We had to

pay \$16,978.72 in repair on the Posi-Shell applicator that we had to lease from Posi-Shell last year.

RECOMMENDATIONS:

Recommend that the Board of Commissioners award the bid to RUSMAR.

Sufficient funds are available for purchase of this Alternate Daily Cover.



Whereas, both state and local governments have begun the budget process for their 2010-2011 fiscal year budgets; and

Whereas, state revenue forecasts for the 2010-2011 fiscal year have not been positive making the balancing of state and local government budgets challenging for yet another year; and

Whereas, in previous fiscal years, in order to balance its budget, the North Carolina General Assembly has taken revenue sources that were previously available to and traditionally counted on by local governments and have moved services previously performed by state government to local governments without providing revenue sources to pay for such services; and

Whereas, balancing state budgets by taking local government revenue sources and by mandating that local governments provide services that have been traditionally performed by the state, without providing new revenue sources to the local governments, has severely strained local government finances and has resulted in significant cuts to local government budgets and services; and

Whereas, in fiscal year 2009-2010 in order to balance their budgets, local governments made significant budget cuts resulting in a decrease in local government services, lost wages, benefits to local government employees and lost jobs; and

Whereas, if the General Assembly again takes additional revenues that have been traditionally allocated to local governments and/or imposes additional unfunded mandates upon local governments, additional service cuts, lost public wages, benefits and lost jobs will most certainly result; and

Whereas, as the state and the nation try to recover from the worst recession in the last 75 years, it is imperative that we do not further reduce services, wages and jobs.

Now, therefore be it resolved that the Cumberland County Board of Commissioners requests that the North Carolina General Assembly take no action that would place additional financial burdens on local governments as they are currently strained and cannot afford or absorb revenue reductions or unfunded mandates in the coming fiscal year.
