Action on Tax Collector's Preliminary Report and Proposed Annual Settlement

BACKGOUND: North Carolina General Statutes, Section 105-373 requires the Tax Collector of Cumberland County after the 1<sup>st</sup> day of July of each year to render a preliminary report to the Board of County Commissioners concerning persons whose tax liabilities remain unpaid and to propose an annual settlement of taxes charged to him for collection for the past year. The Tax Collector has submitted such preliminary report and proposed settlement. The preliminary report consists of (i) a list of persons owning real property whose taxes for the tax year of 2011-2012 remain unpaid, (ii) a list of the persons not owning real property whose taxes for the year 2011-2012 remain unpaid (the proposed insolvent list), and (iii) a statement under oath by the Tax Collector that he has made diligent efforts to collect such taxes. The proposed settlement consists of the amounts of taxes with which the Tax Collector has been charged for the year and the amounts of credits against such charges, the real and personal property tax balance is charged to the forthcoming tax year. See Exhibits A, B and C in the County Clerks Office.

**RECOMMENDATIONS:** The statute requires the Board to review the preliminary report, determine the insolvent list to be entered into the minutes, credit the Tax Collector with the insolvent list and make a settlement, i.e., approve or correct the proposed settlement. The Legal Department has reviewed for legal sufficiency.

**PROPOSED ACTION:** That the Board adopts the resolution attached as Exhibit D.

#### **EXHIBIT D**

Resolution accepting preliminary report of the Tax Collector, crediting the insolvent list, and approving proposed annual settlement.

Whereas, North Carolina General Statutes, Section 105-373, requires the Tax Collector of Cumberland County after the 1<sup>st</sup> day of July of each year to render a preliminary report to the Board of County Commissioners concerning persons whose tax liabilities remain unpaid and to propose an annual settlement of taxes charged to the Tax Collector for collection for the past ten years; and

Whereas, the Tax Collector has submitted such preliminary report and proposed settlement.

Now therefore, the Board of Commissioners of Cumberland County hereby resolves:

- 1. That the preliminary report of the Tax Collector of Cumberland County, consisting of (i) a list of persons owning real property whose taxes for the year 2011- 2012 remain unpaid and the principal amount owned by each person; (ii) a list of the persons not owning or who have not listed real property whose taxes for the tax year 2011 2012 remain unpaid and the principal amount owned by each person (the proposed insolvent list) and (iii) a statement under oath by the Tax Collector that he has made diligent efforts to collect such taxes, be and it hereby is, accepted;
- 2. That the Board hereby finds that the persons in the list of those that do not own or have not listed real property are insolvent as that term is used in G.S. 105-373, directs that the list of such person be entered into the minutes of the meeting of the Board as the insolvent list, and further directs that the amounts in such list be, and hereby are, credited to the Tax Collector in his annual settlement;
- 3. That the proposed settlement of the Tax Collector, appended hereto, for taxes in his hands for collection for the tax year 2011 2012, be and it hereby is, approved and that he be, and thereby is, charged with the amounts set forth in the settlement under the heading "Charges" and credited with the amounts set forth in the settlement under the heading "Credits".

NOW THEREFORE, in order to clearly define the responsibilities and terms and conditions of employment of the COUNTY CLERK, the County of Cumberland (hereinafter referred to as COUNTY) and COUNTY CLERK agree as follows:

#### COUNTY CLERK WILL:

Serve as COUNTY CLERK to the Board of County Commissioners and to perform all duties inherent therein.

#### II.

#### THE COUNTY WILL:

- Pay the COUNTY CLERK a yearly base salary of SIXTY SIX THOUSAND THREE HUNDRED TWENTY DOLLARS (\$66,320.00), plus an employer 401(k) account contribution of one percent of salary.
- Pay the COUNTY CLERK a monthly salary supplement in the amount of TWO HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$200.00) in lieu of any in-County travel allowance, with the full amount of this supplement being subject to all withholding and retirement contribution.
- 3. Pay the Clerk the same amount of any annual stipend or bonus as paid to all other employees.

#### III.

## THE COUNTY AND THE COUNTY CLERK MUTUALLY AGREE AND ACKNOWLEDGE THAT:

- All provisions of the County Personnel Code which are applicable to the COUNTY CLERK
  and not in conflict with the provisions of this contract shall continue to govern and
  supplement the terms and conditions of employment of the COUNTY CLERK.
- This agreement shall be effective July 1, 2013 and shall continue to and through June 30, 2014.
- The BOARD has the right with or without cause to terminate the employment of the COUNTY CLERK. In such event, the COUNTY shall provide the COUNTY CLERK with

§ 143-318.10. All official meetings of public bodies open to the public.

- (a) Except as provided in G.S. 143-318.11, 143-318.14A, and 143-318.18, each official meeting of a public body shall be open to the public, and any person is entitled to attend such a meeting.
- (b) As used in this Article, "public body" means any elected or appointed authority, board, commission, committee, council, or other body of the State, or of one or more counties, cities, school administrative units, constituent institutions of The University of North Carolina, or other political subdivisions or public corporations in the State that (i) is composed of two or more members and (ii) exercises or is authorized to exercise a legislative, policy-making, quasi-judicial, administrative, or advisory function. In addition, "public body" means the governing board of a "public hospital" as defined in G.S. 159-39 and the governing board of any nonprofit corporation to which a hospital facility has been sold or conveyed pursuant to G.S. 131E-8, any subsidiary of such nonprofit corporation, and any nonprofit corporation owning the corporation to which the hospital facility has been sold or conveyed.
- (c) "Public body" does not include (i) a meeting solely among the professional staff of a public body, or (ii) the medical staff of a public hospital or the medical staff of a hospital that has been sold or conveyed pursuant to G.S. 131E-8.
- (d) "Official meeting" means a meeting, assembly, or gathering together at any time or place or the simultaneous communication by conference telephone or other electronic means of a majority of the members of a public body for the purpose of conducting hearings, participating in deliberations, or voting upon or otherwise transacting the public business within the jurisdiction, real or apparent, of the public body. However, a social meeting or other informal assembly or gathering together of the members of a public body does not constitute an official meeting unless called or held to evade the spirit and purposes of this Article.
- (e) Every public body shall keep full and accurate minutes of all official meetings, including any closed sessions held pursuant to G.S. 143-318.11. Such minutes may be in written form or, at the option of the public body, may be in the form of sound or video and sound recordings. When a public body meets in closed session, it shall keep a general account of the closed session so that a person not in attendance would have a reasonable understanding of what transpired. Such accounts may be a written narrative, or video or audio recordings. Such minutes and accounts shall be public records within the meaning of the Public Records Law, G.S. 132-1 et seq.; provided, however, that minutes or an account of a closed session conducted in compliance with G.S. 143-318.11 may be withheld from public inspection so long as public inspection would frustrate the purpose of a closed session. (1979, c. 655, s. 1; 1985 (Reg. Sess., 1986), c. 932, s. 4; 1991, c. 694, ss. 1, 2; 1993 (Reg. #### **BACKGROUND**

Informal bids were received on July 25, 2013 for HVAC upgrades to the Law Enforcement Center (LEC) located on Dick Street. The existing HVAC system is not adequate to provide sufficient cooling to the 911 server room as well as the Sheriff's Department server room. This project will also replace the emergency water-cooled chiller that is located within the basement with a new air cooled chiller outside of the building. Attached are the certified bid tabulation and the project engineer's (Progressive Design Collaborative, LTD) letter of recommendation. The low bid was submitted by Ivey Mechanical in the amount of \$286,963. In addition, a 5% contingency in the amount of \$14,348 is recommended to address any changes that may arise during construction. The attached budget revision will appropriate the needed funding for this project.



#### BACKGROUND

In 2012, the North Carolina Division of Health & Human Services (DHHS) began electronic implementation of its programs into a system known as NC Families Accessing Services through Technology (NC FAST). The implementation has been conducted in phases and currently includes Food Stamps, Medicaid, Work First, Special Assistance/Long Term Care, and Refugee Assistance programs. Implementation of programs such as child care and energy will be phased into the system at a later date. Due to the new technological service delivery model introduced by NC FAST, impending changes in federal/state mandates related to health care and fiscal challenges; DHHS developed a model to incorporate changes, maximize customer self-sufficiency, and reduce administrative churn, i.e. Work Support Strategies (WSS). County Departments of Social Services have been charged with local implementation of WSS. Cumberland County Department of Social Services (CCDSS) decided to implement local WSS around the alignment of state, county, and agency strategic goals; while centrally focusing on enhanced service delivery to citizens. Effective, August 1, 2013, CCDSS has internally transitioned and implemented the initial phases of local DSS Work Support Strategies.

Attached you will find a Work Support Strategies Implementation Plan PowerPoint hardcopy which has been presented to DSS Economic Services staff, the DSS Board, and County Management.

- Without changes at the Presidential & Congressional levels, impact will be felt at state and county levels for the next 10 years
- Approx. 250 grants in DHHS may be affected; 8 of the 250 grants are for older adults (Title 3-B) the reduction of about 12%:
  - congregate meals 8%
  - Home & Community Care Block Grant assuming a 5% reduction would be \$2 million affecting over 2600 seniors statewide

# North Carolina Families Accessing Services through Technology (NC FAST)

# NC FAST is the new way counties will determine eligibility services. State's implementation schedule:

- Project 1 Food and Nutritional Services (food stamps)
  - Began in July 2012 with applications; final implementation in November 2012
- Project 2/6 Medicaid, Work 1<sup>st</sup> Cash and Refugee Assistance
  - Begins August 5, 2013 with applications
  - October/November 2013 for current active cases
- Project 7 Affordable Care Act
  - Begin accepting applications October 1, 2013
  - Services effective January 1, 2013
- Project 3 Child Care & Energy Assistance
  - Expected to launch early 2014



## **North Carolina ePASS**

ePASS is the public portal for citizens to apply for services on-line using NC FAST.

## State's ePASS implementation schedule:

- April 2013 launched Food & Nutrition Services (food stamps)
- June 2013 expanded to include Medicaid applications






