




Atlantic Coast Pipeline



Property Values and Mortgages

- After reviewing several studies, the FERC reports most recently in October 2014, that there is no consistent information suggesting that the presence of a natural gas pipeline easement would decrease property values.
 - Diskin et. al., 2011 (Arizona)
 - PGP Valuation, Inc., 2008 (Palomar Gas Transmission)
 - Ecowest, 2008 (Oregon LNG Project)
 - Hansen et. al., 2006 (Washington State)
- Because property values would not be affected, appraisal values would not be affected and therefore ability to obtain a mortgage would not be affected.

Property Insurance

- The FERC recently reported that it was unable to confirm specific affects on property insurance
- The potential for a residential insurance policy to be affected depends on
 - Terms of the individual land owner's policy
 - Terms of the applicant's (project proposer's) policy
- As a result, the FERC recommends project proposers
 - Document pipeline-related complaints concerning homeowner insurance policies
 - Describe mitigation efforts
 - Report on this issue regularly to the FERC

BACKGROUND

Cumberland County Department of Social Services (DSS) and Child Support have completed the process for acquiring an Enterprise Content Management (ECM) system which incorporates document management, workflow, and forms building. During the acquisition process, the ECM Subject Matter Expert (SME) committee went through a rigorous process to document their requirements, conduct site visits, and participate in vendor demos.

Five responses to the requests for proposals were received. After thorough review of the proposals, the steering committee decided to partner with Northwoods for the purchase of their Laserfiche product. Northwoods (Laserfiche) was the lowest responsible bidder meeting all requirements of the County. The cost of the project which falls within budget is \$603,262.

A budget revision was approved by the Board of Commissioners on October 20, 2014.

RECOMMENDATION/PROPOSED ACTION

The Information Services Department has reviewed the bids and was a part of the selection process and is requesting to proceed with awarding the bid as recommended to Northwoods.

BACKGROUND

In accordance with North Carolina General Statute 18B-805(h), Expenditure of Alcoholism Funds: Funds distributed under subdivisions (b)(4) and (c)(3) of this section shall be spent for the treatment of alcoholism or substance abuse or for research or education on alcohol or substance abuse. The minutes of the board of county commissioners or local board spending funds allocated under this subsection shall describe the activity for which the funds are to be spent. Any agency or person receiving funds from the county commissioners or local board under this subsection shall submit an annual report to the board of county commissioners or local board from which funds were received, describing how the funds were spent.

For fiscal year 2014 collections related to (b)(4) totaled \$87,607; collections related to (c)(3) totaled \$166,325; for a combined total of \$253,932. To be in compliance with this statute, Alliance Behavioral Healthcare has reported that provider agency "Trust the Process" provided substance abuse intensive outpatient services totaling \$273,000 to 87 substance abuse consumers over the course of the fiscal year.

RESOLUTION OF THE CUMBERLAND COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS ENDORSING THE INSTALLATION OF TURN LANES ON RIVER ROAD AT THE RELOCATED UNDERWOOD ROAD INTERSECTION

WHEREAS, the Cargill Fayetteville Plant has plans for expansion and modernization over the next two years; and

WHEREAS, the Cargill Fayetteville Plant will relocate Underwood Road to help facilitate the expansion plans and allow for improved control of plant security at Cargill's cost; and

WHEREAS, the Cargill Fayetteville Plant plans on performing a complete automation rework for the prep and extraction plant which will entail rewiring every motor and control device in the facility and is expected to employ six to ten electricians full time for eighteen months to two years; and

WHEREAS, the Cargill Fayetteville Plant will build a new main office and maintenance shop on the newly acquired property north of the existing plant and will install a new vertical seed conditioner and a new extractor; and

WHEREAS, the total capital outlay is expected to be between \$25 to \$30 million and there is no cost to the County of Cumberland; and

WHEREAS, the expansion will increase the plant throughout by 10% and will most likely lead to an additional five to ten full time jobs and will provide significant contract work for the local community for a period of two to three years; and

WHEREAS, there is also the potential for the merchandizing team to be relocated to Fayetteville from Raleigh as a result of the construction of a new office building at this site.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Cumberland County Board of Commissioners endorses the installation of turn lanes on River Road at the relocated Underwood Road intersection that will be constructed by the Cargill Fayetteville Plant as part of their plant expansion plan.

RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF PROTECTING THE UNITED STATES POSTAL SERVICE'S MAIL PROCESSING CENTER AND SERVICE STANDARDS IN FAYETTEVILLE, NORTH CAROLINA

WHEREAS, in January 2015, the United States Postal Service plans to begin implementing phase two of the Network Rationalization plan and consolidate up to 82 mail processing facilities, three of which are in North Carolina, and eliminate the overnight service standard requirement for all first-class mail and periodicals; and

WHEREAS, under that plan most processing operations in Fayetteville will be moved to Raleigh and Charlotte; and

WHEREAS, the action has the potential to affect 282 full-time employees in Fayetteville; and

WHEREAS, local overnight mail service is important to the county's businesses and citizens; and

WHEREAS, this move will cause a slowdown in the delivery of mail within our community, which is an especially difficult challenge to those who depend on the Postal Service for business activities, elderly citizens who receive printed social security and pension checks and nearly every citizen who will now experience a shorter window in which to make important financial payments to banks, utilities and other companies, due to additional time their bills will spend in the US Postal System; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners is committed to Cumberland County's economic development, job retention and business climate; and

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Cumberland County Board of Commissioners strongly opposes plans to shift most mail processing operations from Fayetteville to Raleigh and Charlotte and recommends the Postal Service consider other cost-cutting measures; and

FURTHER, BE IT RESOLVED, that copies of this Resolution be sent to the United States Post Master General and the Congressional delegation.

- (b) Any person who holds an elective office in State or local government is hereby authorized by the General Assembly, pursuant to Article VI, Sec. 9 of the North Carolina Constitution to hold concurrently one other appointive office, place of trust or profit, in either State or local government.

- (a) Any person who holds an appointive office, place of trust or profit in State or local government is hereby authorized by the General Assembly, pursuant to Article VI, Sec. 9 of the North Carolina Constitution, to hold concurrently one other appointive office, place of trust or profit, or an elective office in either State or local government.
- (b) Any person who holds an elective office in State or local government is hereby authorized by the General Assembly, pursuant to Article VI, Sec. 9 of the North Carolina Constitution to hold concurrently one other appointive office, place of trust or profit, in either State or local government.
- (c) Any person who holds an office or position in the federal postal system or is commissioned as a special officer or deputy special officer of the United States Bureau of Indian Affairs is hereby authorized to hold concurrently therewith one position in State or local government.
- (c1) Where authorized by federal law, any State or local law enforcement agency may authorize its law enforcement officers to also perform the functions of an officer under 8 U.S.C. § 1357(g) if the agency has a Memorandum of Agreement or Memorandum of Understanding for that purpose with a federal agency. State and local law enforcement officers authorized under this provision are authorized to hold any office or position with the applicable federal agency required to perform the described functions.
- (d) The term "elective office," as used herein, shall mean any office filled by election by the people when the election is conducted by a county board of elections under the supervision of the State Board of Elections. (1971, c. 697, s. 2; 1975, c. 174; 1987, c. 427, s. 10; 2006-259, s. 24(a); 2011-31, s. 13.)

Southeastern Economic Development Commission BY-LAWS

ARTICLE V

Membership

Section 1. The Commission shall be comprised of four (4) members from each county in the District. At least one (1) of these members shall be an elected official that could include a County Commissioner, Mayor, or City Council Member. The membership is to be reflective of the minority population of the area served to comply with civil rights requirements of the Economic Development Administration (EDA). Minority representation from each member county shall reflect the minority population within the respective county making an appointment; however, no member county shall have less than twenty-five percent (25%) of its representation as minority.

The Commission Board of Directors shall at all times comply with current EDA regulations and guidelines. The Board shall have at least one Private Sector Representative. Private Sector Representative means with respect to any for-profit enterprise, any senior management official or executive holding a key decision making position, or that person's designee. The Board shall also contain at least one additional representative of the following: Executive Directors of Chambers of Commerce, or representatives of institutions of post-secondary education, workforce development groups or labor groups, all of which must comprise in the aggregate a minimum of thirty-five (35) percent of the Commission's governing body. The governing body shall also have at least a simple majority of its membership who are elected officials and/or employees of a general purpose unit of State, local, or Indian tribal government who have been appointed to represent the government.

Section 2. Members to the Commission shall be appointed by the respective Boards of County Commissioners by appropriate resolutions. Members so appointed will be designated for a term of four years to serve at the pleasure of the parent Board of

County Commissioners. Appointing officials should take into consideration the provisions of the Civil Rights Act of 1965.

Section 3. The terms of the Commission Members shall be, insofar as practicable on a staggered basis insuring an appointment or reappointment each year. Such appointments shall be made prior to the April meeting, which meeting shall also be the Annual Meeting of the Commission.

Section 4. The Executive Director shall notify the appointing authority in writing of the expiration date of the terms of Commission members. Appointment or reappointment action will be requested.

Section 5. The Executive Director will have available a roster of currently qualified Commission Members. Voting privileges will be extended only to those so qualified to vote.
