1) Public Health - Budget Ordinance Amendment B170633 to increase salary and benefits in the amount of \$4,025

The Board is requested to approve Budget Ordinance Amendment B170633 in the amount of \$4,025. The current employee in position 118002510 has met experience requirements as a fully qualified Public Health Nurse II. Based on current personnel policy the employee is entitled to a salary increase. This increase will be funded by through the contract with Cumberland County Schools. This contract currently funds the cost of ten Nurse II positions for 35 hours per week.

2) Public Health - Budget Ordinance Amendment B170808 to recognize \$26,446 to purchase a vehicle

BACKGROUND

At the Board of Health meeting on November 8, 2016, the Board approved writing off a total of \$17,300.89 as bad debts. The bad debt accounts, with balances of \$50.00 or higher, will be processed through the North Carolina Debt Set-Off Program. This program can attach a debtor's State Income Tax refund for payment of bad debts. The accounts with balances under \$50.00 will continue to be worked for collection through our in-house collection efforts. This write-off of bad debts is in compliance with the Board of Health's recommendation to write-off bad debts every quarter.

Approve write off of \$17,300.89 bad debts to the North Carolina Debt Set-Off Program.
