5. Affordable Housing Program Guidelines

Thenena Wilson, Community Development Director, gave a brief overview of the draft Cumberland County Community Development Affordable Housing Program Guidelines. Some of the guideline highlights included allowing non-profit/community housing organizations (10 points); minority and women owned businesses (10 points); past residential projects completed (10 points); site evaluation (30 points). She stated that 5 points consideration was given to projects in which the owner provides a minimum 5% equity investment. Those projects in which repayment of principal and interest begins immediately after loan closing will receive 10 points.
