This special meeting was called for the County Manager to present his proposed budget for FY2007-08.

## HIGHLIGHTS PRESENTED:

Tax Rate: 88.0 cents per \$100 valuation (each one cent on the tax rate generates \$1,552,074);

Collection Rate: 97.84% for real/personal property and 82.26% for vehicles;

General Fund Budget: \$271,017,305 (an increase of 3.77% over FY2007);

Appropriation from Fund Balance: \$8,011,250 (3% of the FY2008 recurring expenditures). Another \$3,072,207 has been appropriated for one-time expenditures along with an additional \$1,000,0000 of one-time revenue.

Undesignated Fund Balance: 10.84%

COLA: 4% Recommended (not less than \$1,000);

Other designated expenditures: (not directly budgeted, but rather will represent a designation of General Fund fund balance in the county's FY2007 audit report)

Maintenance/renovation projects: \$3,149,656

Software for the Tax Office:\$655,072Revaluation expenses:\$150,000Medicaid increases:\$1,500,000New County Health Department:\$3,166,150

Current Expense Funding for Schools: \$68,291,257 (an increase of

\$2,942,717 or 4.50 %)

Current Expense Funding for FTCC: \$7,977,015 (\$268,752 increase)

Reduction of departmental budgets: \$737,386

Future Initiatives: Issuance of \$55 million in COPS to fund construction of two new

schools and classrooms to replace existing huts.

New Western Branch Library to be built in conjunction with new

western elementary school

A capital project fund has been established in the amount of \$1.466 million to fund preliminary design and engineering work on the new Health Department building. The projected \$22 million facility will require annual debt service payments of \$1,518,700.

Total funding for outside agencies; \$1,510,064

Mental Health Fund: \$30,785,625

Recreation Tax: 5 cents

Fire District Tax: 10 cents

Special Fire District Tax: ½ cent

TOTAL COUNTY-WIDE BUDGET: \$560,188,325 (0.08% Increase)

Other Issues Discussed:

Inadequate funding for some of the fire departments; Accountability for all agencies receiving county funds; School crossing guards
