Tom Lloyd, Planning Director, reviewed the process for the preparation of the 2030 Plan. Work on this plan has been ongoing for almost four years.

Mr. Lloyd told the Board that the 2030 Growth Vision Plan includes the Land Use Policies Plan, Small Area Plans and Special Studies Plans.

The 2030 Growth Vision Plan outlines future goals, sets general policies, and maps the desired and intensity of growth areas. The Land Use Policies Plan outlines location criteria for various land uses, outlines ideal relationship between land uses and functions as a guide for making rezoning decisions. The Area Land Use Plans outlines the Public's desire for a specific area, provides more parcel specific information on land uses and functions as a guide for making rezoning decisions. The Special Studies Plans addresses specific areas/streets. Some examples are the Reilly Road Study, Hope Mills Road Study, Highway 24 Study, Ramsey Street Study, Cypress Lakes Mini Study, Hazard Mitigation Plan, Wade Open Space Plan, Falcon Open Space Plan, Stedman Pedestrian & Greenway Plan and other research requests.
